As a reminder, we capped our membership at 300 on September 1, 2014. As of the Board of Directors meeting held on Tuesday, September 27 and the acceptance of the 3 new applicants for membership, we are all capped out. All new applicants for membership to Horse Pond Fish & Game Club will be put on a wait list. This is the first time in our history that we have actually reached 300.

We need to make sure that all members and their guests are familiar with our range rules. It is quite evident that many of our new members are unfamiliar with the rules governing the use of the rifle range. All members MUST display the current membership badge with the lanyard supplied by Horse Pond F&GC. Please be sure that all guests stop and read the posted RANGE RULES prior to approaching the platform. Members are the supervisors for their guests and they cannot shoot at the same time as their family guest. Remember, this is a must. And, only one guest at a time is allowed to accompany a member at the range.

As we move forward toward the fall hunting seasons we remind everyone that the range will very active. Be sure to follow the RANGE RULES 100%.

- 1-Wear and display your current membership badge at all times.
- 2-Always control the muzzle of your gun/rifle down range.
- 3-Always respect other members and their guests.
- 4-Alcohol is never permitted at the range.
- 5-Remove your paper targets and spent brass when finished shooting.
- 6-Keep the range gate opened when members are at the range.
- 7-You must CLOSE and LOCK the gate when the last member leaves.

- The outdoor archery targets have been set up and hung. Please do not use broad-heads on these targets. Retrieve all of your arrows and equipment when you are finished shooting. You can use cross bows with these targets.
- The Shooting Sports are currently shooting center fire handguns. They are active on Wednesday afternoons after 3 pm.
- Now is the time to order your hoodies and jackets for fall.
