- 4-Alcohol is never permitted at the range.
- 5-Remove your paper targets and spent brass when finished shooting.
- 6-Keep the range gate opened when members are at the range
- 7-You must close and lock the gate when the last member leaves.

- The outdoor archery targets have been set up and hung. Please do not use broad-heads on these targets. Retrieve all of your arrows and equipment when you are finished shooting. You can use cross bows with these targets.
- Please be sure to familiarize yourself with the rules and regulations of the Rifle Range. Current membership badges MUST be worn at all times. And, the Family Membership Badge must be worn by your family guests. You cannot shoot at the same time as your guest, you must supervise them. You are 100% responsible for your guest following the rules.
- The Shooting Sports will be starting the center-fire pistol league next. They shoot on Wednesday afternoons starting at 3 pm.
- Dennis Dean tells me that we have openings for 3 new members. Remember, we are capped at 300 members.
